# Welcome

Wyke is a one form entry school with a countryside, village feel. We are a Unicef Rights Respecting school and this ethos runs through everything that we do. Our focus at Wyke is on the whole child. Alongside our high behaviour and work expectations, we ensure that each child receives a broad and balanced curriculum and the chance to experience and take part in a wide range of activities. It is a school where we strive to inspire life-long learners and encourage pupils to be the best that they can be through building resilience and perseverance and celebrating all our achievements!



Wyke offers spacious grounds, including a large playing field, a pond area, a sensory garden and a woodland area. We have a trim trail and climbing frame and a timetabled football pitch. We have a separate Early Years block where our Reception children have their own entrance and



outside area.

The children also have access to a well-stocked library. Our classrooms are light and spacious, offering a bright and positive learning environment for all children.



## *Curriculum*

At Wyke we work hard to offer a broad and balanced curriculum that engages and enthuses our pupils. We follow the National Curriculum and integrate it with themed weeks



and cross-curricular working opportunities. Our curriculum ensures that skills are progressively covered and learning is built on year-on-year in each year group. Experiences offered through the curriculum engage and excite the children, fostering a real love of learning and

enabling them to achieve and be prepared for the next phase of their school journey. Classes learn the recorder and ukelele and have the opportunity to have guitar, keyboard and trumpet lessons. Our IT provision includes an ICT Suite where children access coding and computing skills. Within the classrooms, iPads are used to support cross-curricular learning.



## *Trips*

Each year group go on at least 3 educational visits a year. The visits are linked to the learning that is being done in class. This is also supported by visits from outside companies and providers to further enhance the children's experiences. Each year group also complete a course of swimming each year.

## *Wrap around Care*

The school offers a breakfast club from 7:30 until 8:45, as well as an after school club from 15:15 until 18:00. These are available to book online in blocks or on an ad-hoc basis.

## *Clubs*

Wyke offers a wide range of clubs. This includes: cross country, athletics, modellers making guild, football, netball, science club, art club, choir, creative writing and gardening. The clubs rotate each term so that different age groups are able to participate. Clubs take place after school and during lunchtimes.

## *PTA*

Wyke has a very active PTA. 'Friends of Wyke' organise and run many exciting events across the year for both children and families. The money raised enables the school to purchase items and offer the children an even better experience at Wyke across the year. Events include film nights, Christmas Fair, summer fair, quiz nights, bingo, discos and cake sales.
