
Legionella Awareness Training (Half Day)

The course introduces the recommendations of the HSE Approved Code of Practice L8 and HSG274- Legionnaires' disease: Technical Guidance (2014) Part 2, including the Requirements of the Responsible persons for legionella control and ongoing maintenance and monitoring duties. If required the course can include more detailed information on Evaporative Cooling Towers as well as practical demonstration of duties such as hot and cold temperature monitoring.
