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1 Introduction

Within The Kite Academy Trust, we wish to promote an atmosphere which encourages effort, enjoyment and a celebration of the achievements of all our children. Our academies have high standards and expectations and this is reflected in the pride taken in our uniforms and the feeling of belonging they create. All children are expected to dress in full uniform. Our uniforms:

- unite academy communities and give an identity to be part of and proud of: children learn, practise, play and succeed together.
- reduce distractions: children are focused on learning.
- make everyone equal: children come to school looking the same way; no child has to feel awkward about the clothes they have or don't have.
- are professional: children look smart and are ready to learn.

By creating a common identity amongst all children, regardless of background, a school uniform can act as a social leveller. It can reduce bullying and peer pressure to wear the latest fashions or other expensive clothes. Uniform should not, however, be so expensive that it places an unreasonable burden on families. Parents should not have to consider the cost of a school uniform when choosing a school for their child. It is therefore important to us to ensure that our uniforms are readily available and affordable.

2 Equality & Diversity

The Equality Act 2010 prohibits discrimination against an individual based on the protected characteristics, which include sex, race, religion or belief, and gender reassignment. To avoid discrimination, our academies will:

- avoid listing uniform items based on sex, to give all children the opportunity to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in;
- make sure that our uniform costs the same for all children;
- allow all children to have long hair (though we reserve the right to ask for this to be tied back);
- allow all children to style their hair in the way that is appropriate for school yet makes them feel most comfortable (i.e. long hair should be tied back);
- allow children to request changes to swimwear for religious reasons;
- allow children to wear headscarves and other religious or cultural symbols;
- allow for adaptations to this policy on the grounds of equality. Parents should contact the Academy Headteacher with any questions about the policy or requests for adaptations.

3 Cost of Academy Uniform

The Kite Academy Trust has a responsibility to make sure that our academy uniforms are affordable, in line with statutory guidance from the Department for Education on the cost of school uniform.

We understand that items with distinctive characteristics (such as items with a logo or a unique fabric/colour/design) cannot be purchased from a wide range of retailers and that this limits parents' ability to 'shop around' for a low price.

In line with our responsibility, we will ensure that required uniform items:

- are available at a reasonable cost;
- provide the best value for money for families.

We will do this by:

- carefully considering whether any items with distinctive characteristics/logos are necessary;
- limiting items with distinctive characteristics/logos as far as possible, and to low-cost or long-lasting items;

- considering cheaper alternatives to academy-branded items, such as logos that can be ironed on, as long as this doesn't compromise quality and durability;
- avoiding specific requirements for items children could wear on non-school days, such as coats, bags and shoes;
- avoiding different uniform requirements for extra-curricular activities;
- considering alternative methods for signalling differences in groups for interschool competitions, such as creating posters or labels;
- making sure that arrangements are in place for parents to acquire second-hand uniform items;
- avoiding frequent changes to uniform specifications and minimising the financial impact on parents of any changes;
- consulting with parents and children on any proposed significant changes to the uniform requirements and carefully considering any complaints about this policy.

In order to ensure that uniform supplier arrangements give the highest priority to cost and value for money, the Department for Education's guidance regarding single supplier contracts will be considered and re-tendering of contracts undertaken as required.

4 Uniform Requirements

Each academy in the Trust has its own uniform. Please see Appendix A for individual academy requirements.

5 Expectations for our Academy Communities

Children

Children are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times (other than specified non-uniform days) while:

- on academy premises;
- travelling to and from school;
- at out-of-school events or on trips that are organised by an academy, or where they are representing the academy (if required).

Parents & Carers

Parents and carers are expected to make sure their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that every item is:

- clean;
- clearly labelled with the child's name;
- in good condition.

Parents should contact the Academy Headteacher if they wish to request an amendment to the uniform requirements in relation to their child's protected characteristics, or if they wish to raise a concern regarding the cost of the academy uniform.

Parents are expected to lodge any complaints or objections relating to the academy uniform in a timely and reasonable manner. Our academies are committed to working closely with parents to arrive at a mutually acceptable outcome. Where a mutually acceptable resolution cannot be reached, formal complaints will be dealt with in accordance with The Kite Academy Trust's Academy Complaints Policy.

Staff

Staff will closely monitor children to make sure they are in correct uniform. They will give any children and families breaching the uniform policy the opportunity to comply, but will raise ongoing non-compliance with the Academy Headteacher.

In cases where it is suspected that financial hardship has resulted in a child not complying with the uniform policy, staff will take a mindful and considerate approach to resolving the situation.

6 Monitoring of the Policy

This policy and its implementation will be monitored to ensure that it is appropriate for the Trust's context, offers uniform requirements that are appropriate, practical and safe for all children, and is implemented fairly across the Trust.

Where significant changes to the uniform requirements are proposed, children and parents will be consulted and their views taken into account.

At every review period, this policy will be ratified by the Trust Board.
